

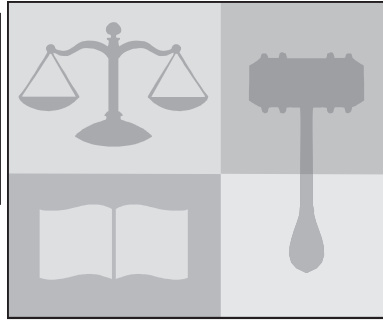

FEBRUARY DINNER MEETING SPEAKER

COLONEL MARK MacCARLEY

UNITED STATES ARMY AND GLENDALE ATTORNEY

TOPIC: *CONTRACTORS, CONTRACTING AND THE GLOBAL WAR ON TERRORISM*

Our February speaker is Attorney Mark MacCarley. He has recently returned from fifteen months of Active Duty with the United States Army in Kuwait and Iraq, serving as the Chief of Staff for the 377th Theater Support Command - the senior United States military logistics command for all of the Middle East. During his service, he has received the Bronze Star, The Meritorious Service Medal with 4 Oak Leaf Clusters and the Army Commendation Medal.

Colonel MacCarley's topic will be *Contractors and Contracting - A Warfighting Enabler - The Fourth Column in the Global War on Terrorism*. Mark documented his tour of duty photographically and will share some of his photographs during his presentation. He will focus on a number of the knotty and

troublesome legal issues that have arisen between the U.S. Military and the multitude of civilian contractors on the battlefield. Mark is eager to get back to the practice of law. He is a partner with the Glendale law firm of MacCarley & Rosen and specializes in real estate, business, labor, and probate litigation. Mark is a life long Glendale - Burbank resident who has only left town for military service. He received his undergraduate degree from California State University at Northridge in 1972. He is a 1975 graduate of Loyola Law School in Los Angeles. He has a Masters Degree in Strategic Studies from the United States Army War College.

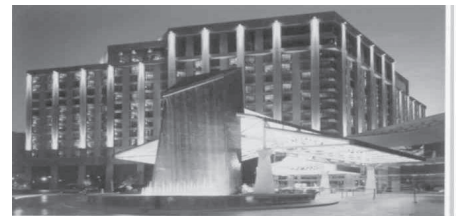
