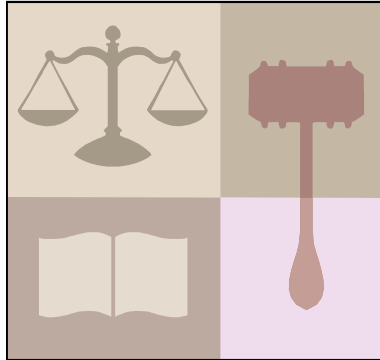

TOPIC: *The White Collar Client*

We are honored to have the Honorable Dickran Tevrizian as our monthly Dinner Meeting/Seminar speaker for the May 23, 2007. Judge Tevrizian's one hour CLE presentation is entitled "What to Do When Your Corporate Client Becomes the Focus of White Collar Criminal Investigation?" Judge Tevrizian recently retired as the Senior Judge of United States District Court, Central District of California. He graduated *cum laude* from USC with a B.S. in finance in 1962. He received his J.D. from USC Law School. He was appointed to the Judiciary in 1971 by Ronald Regan. This was the youngest such appointed at the time. He had a distinguished private practice career with the top law firms of Kirtland & Packard, Mannet, Phelps, Tothenberg & Tunney and Of Counsel with Lewis, D'Amato, Brisbois & Bisgaard. Judge Tevrizian has been frequently honored for his many accomplishments but is most well known for his integrity, fairness and deep commitment to mentoring young lawyers.
