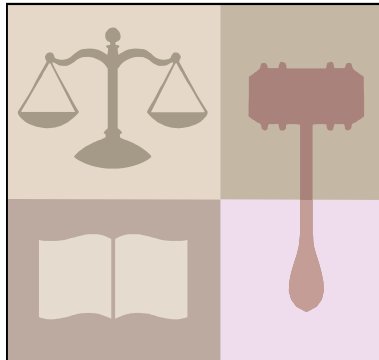

NOVEMBER DINNER MEETING SPEAKER: RICHARD HUTTON, ESQ

Topic: Handling the High Profile and Celebrity Criminal Defendant

Richard received his JD from UCLA in 1970. He has and continues to represent many high profile and celebrity clients. He is past President of the Los Angeles County Criminal Courts Bar Association, former President of the Glendale Bar Association, member of the Board of Governors of the California Attorneys for Criminal Justice and is currently the President of the California Deuce Defenders. He is a founding member of the National College of DUI Defense. Richard, formerly of Glendale, is presently a partner in the Pasadena law firm of Hutton & Wilson. He has been designated a Certified Criminal Law Specialist by the California State Bar Board of Legal Specialization and has tried over 400 jury trials. He also represents organizations before the California Assembly Legislative Committee regarding proposed legislation. In 1991, Richard received the Jerry Giesler Memorial Award from the Criminal Courts Bar Association for his outstanding courtroom skills and abilities. He lectures extensively in the area of criminal law, has taught at the USC Advanced Professionalism Program on DUI and has talked before major bar associations on DUI and criminal justice. He is an author of numerous articles on DUI that have been published in periodicals, including Scientific and Expert Evidence, Second Edition.

(Jerry Giesler, a founder of the CCBA, was, not coincidentally, also the "attorney-to-the-stars." He was perhaps best known as a formidable divorce attorney when divorce was divorce, representing such celebrities as Marilyn Monroe, but he was also an iconic criminal defense attorney who represented celebrities such as Charlie Chaplin, Errol Flynn, Lana Turner and theater mogul Alexander Pantages. The saying back then was "Get me Giesler.")

Giesler was a peerless trial attorney who became a celebrity in his own right. So, the Giesler Award is given in honor of an outstanding trial attorney to an outstanding trial attorney. Others have received the award who have simply contributed to truth and fairness in the criminal justice system. Thought you might like to know.
